

ANNUAL REPORT OF PRACHEEN KALA KENDRA FOR THE YEAR 2022-2023

Pracheen Kala Kendra, a pioneer registered cultural organization since its inception 1956 has registered many many stride in multi-level growth, re-exploration of tradition, growing self-confidence and flowering of creative spirit of Indian culture through its sincere and dedicated efforts. The institution was established on a very firm and sound footing for the propagation, preservation and storing up of the cultural heritage of the country and building bridges between the present and the past. Pracheen Kala Kendra is an organization where art and culture exist in its very core as it is extensively engaged in promotion and preservation of Art and Culture only.

Kendra is a place where artists feel the blessings of Goddess Saraswati, where the ancient classical arts of India are selflessly being preserved for the next generations.

The last 60 years have been a period of continuous growth both in quantity and quality but the year 2020 was a major setback, both morally and financially to the Art world. The culture and arts sector has been one of the most affected by measures all over the world in the Covid 19 epidemic. Despite of this unbearable loss Kendra has done yeoman's service in these trying times. Like previous years, this year was also marked by an all round progress in the various cultural, academic and artistic activities, foremost among them are the holding of examinations, imparting of training, conducting of research and organizing of cultural programmes by inviting top-notch artists of Indian classical music and dance. It was all possible due to the sustained steps taken by the Kendra's dedicated team, as a result of which it was succeeded in maintaining the No. 1 position in the fields of its dedicated service. The Kendra develops ways and means by which basic cultural and aesthetic values and perceptions remain active and dynamic among the people. A report on the activities of the institution during the year 2022-23 is as under:-

WORLDWIDE NETWORK OF CENTRES

The Kendra has a worldwide network of examination centres which specializes in education in the field of art and culture. Its more than 3500 affiliated institutions spread all over the country and abroad including USA, UK, Canada, France, Singapore, Mauritius, UAE, Kuwait, South Africa, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Nepal, etc.

EXAMINATIONS

The examinations of Prarambhik, Bhushan, Visharad and Bhaskar conducted by the Kendra are enjoying all-round recognition. Since the Kendra is a recognized institution and its certificates and diplomas are treated at par with degrees by various State Governments/Education Boards/Universities, as a result of which, as many as 2,70,000 students appeared in different examinations of the Kendra in the session 2022-2023 as compared to the figure of 2,04,592 appeared during the last session, thereby registering an increase of 65000 number of students.

TRAINING

Known for imparting quality training in Indian classical music, dance and fine arts (painting) at its both complexes in Chandigarh and Mohali, the Kendra continued with its effort to educate as well as kindle the interest of young generation in these classical art forms under the guidance of noted teachers of these fields. The Kendra is a recognized institution for fundamental training to foreign students under ICCR scholarship.

MAJOR EVENTS

ANNUAL ALL INDIA BHASKAR RAO NRITYA & SANGEET SAMMELAN, CHANDIGARH

The 51st edition of one of the foremost festival of Classical Music and Dance of India, "All India Bhaskar Rao Nritya & Sangeet Sammelan" was held from 21st to 27th March, 2022 last year at Tagore Theatre Chandigarh. It is one of the mega festivals which covers all the gamuts of Indian Classical Music. This festival has gained immense popularity amongst the artists fraternity and is the most awaited cultural event in which almost every artist wishes and desires to perform. This mega event was studded with acclaimed and immensely talented artists from all over India like Pt. Suresh Talwalkar (Tabla), Dr Harvinder Singh (Vocal), Pt. Pandit Debasish Bhattacharya (Sarod), Dr Tulika Ghosh (Vocal), Pt Partho Bose (Sitar), Pt. Shounak Abhisheki (Vocal), Vidhushi Vyjayanthi Kashi (Kuchipudi dance) Pt. Pravin Godkhindi & Shadaj Godkhindi (flute duet), Pt. Sanjeev Abhayankar (Vocal), Pt Rahul Sharma (Santoor), Vidhushi Padmja Suresh (Bharatnatyam) & Pt. Vishwa Mohan Bhatt (Mohan Veena) and Pt. Sidharth World Renowned Artist Painter, Scholar and Sculptorist) were also felicitated for their outstanding & enormous contribution in their respective fields.

17TH GURU M.L. KOSER AWARD CEREMONY

Through this award Kendra humbly pay tributes to those stalwarts who has rendered remarkable services in the realm of classical art and culture. This award is special and unique because it is a kind of recognition and salute to the talent of an artist by an artist. This award is given in the name of Guru Madan Lal Koser, founder of Pracheen Kala Kendra, a great artist himself an image of personified creativity and epitome of selfless services towards the promotion & dissemination of Indian classical art and culture.

The 17th annual "Guru Madan Lal Koser Award" for excellence in performing arts was presented at a scintillating function at Triveni Kala Sangam, New Delhi on 11th Mar., 2022. Chief Guest Sh. Vinit Goenka, National Spokesperson BJP, New Delhi conferred the award upon Tabla maestros Ustad Ghulam Haider, Ustad Manju Khan and eminent Guru Ustad Zamir Ahmed. Award carried a cash prize of Rs. 31 thousand (each), a shawl, a citation and a memento for their lifetime contribution in popularizing Indian classical music in general. The Award ceremony was followed by remarkable performances by the disciples of the maestros.

10TH GURU M.L. KOSER FESTIVAL OF MUSIC AND DANCE

Pracheen Kala Kendra has resurfaced in the propagation of the Indian Classical Arts after the Covid epidemic, though, Kendra made continuous efforts to promote Classical Music and dance as well as artists even during the Corona period

Kendra has been organizing music programs across the country for the past more than 60 years and for the last 9 years, Pracheen Kala Kendra has been organizing a grand festival in the loving memory of its Founder Guru M.L. Koser. In this mega event being held at New Delhi every year, eminent artists of repute participate with choicest of their performances. The 10th edition of this mega festival was organized from 13 to 14 December, 2022 at Kamani Auditorium, New Delhi. On the inaugural day SNA Awardee Dr. Shobha Koser, Senior Kathak Guru gave a mesmerizing performance which was followed by remarkable Tabla jugalbandi of Ustad Akram Khan and Pt. Yogesh Samsi. The second and concluding day was marked with soulful Vocal recital of Pt. Ajay Pohankar and scintillating Sitar recital of Sh. Purbayan Chatterjee. On both the days Kamani Auditorium was packed to capacity and the performances were appreciated and applauded with standing ovation.

MONTHLY BAITHAKS

For the last more than twenty three years, Kendra has taken continuous efforts to provide a platform amongst others to the upcoming and talented performers in music and dance to showcase their talent. The monthly baithaks which are organized on the 11th of every month are now known worldwide and much sought after event as lot of artists desire and wish to perform on this stage.
